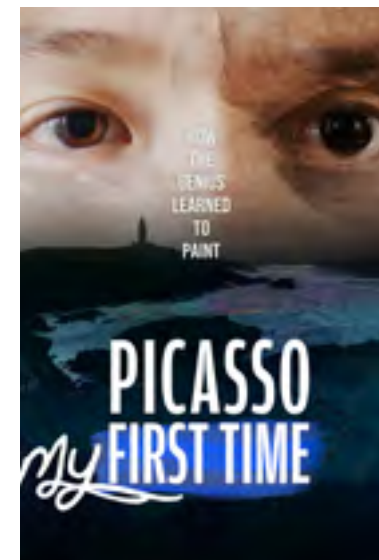


DECODING TURNER

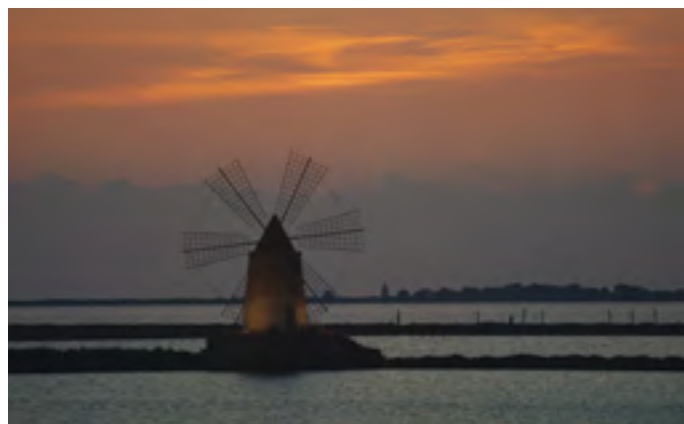

THE MAN WHO WANTED TO CHANGE THE WORLD

Mauro Rostagno was one of the most original and charismatic figures of Italy's recent history – a man who constantly reinvented himself, yet never betrayed his guiding principle: the urgent need to heal himself and the world. From the student revolts of '68 to the leadership of Lotta Continua, from the creation of Macondo – Italy's first social centre – to his search for spirituality in Osho's ashram in India, and finally the foundation of Saman in Sicily, Rostagno's life was a kaleidoscope of change, creativity, and resistance. But in Sicily his mission took on its most dangerous form. Through pioneering, fearless television journalism, he exposed the ties between politics, freemasonry, and the Mafia with irony, intelligence, and unmatched courage. On September 26, 1988, he was assassinated. What followed was a decades-long battle for truth, obscured by false leads, disinformation, and cover-ups – until the Mafia's responsibility was finally recognised. This series brings to light an extraordinary life cut short, and the enduring relevance of Rostagno's uncompromising voice.



WHO MURDERED YOU, MUM?

The brutal killing of his mum when he was a year old, changed Daniel's life forever, 30 years later, her murder remains unsolved and Tina is all but forgotten. Now, Daniel is determined to find out the truth about the tragedy that shaped his past. Who murdered his mum? As Daniel finds out more about the vibrant and happy woman Tina was, tragedies in her past are revealed – and the repercussions of her death on the family become clear. Daniel learns more about the sequence of events that led to Tina's death. As he gets to know her better, his thoughts turn to his father – who was tried and acquitted of Tina's murder. Who did kill Tina? Daniel explores what his mother's story can reveal about an epidemic of violence against women and asks why his mum never got justice.

The series is warm, authentic and relatable with an enormous sprinkling of fun and – unusually for Scotland – sunshine.



PLASTIC SURGERY: RECONSTRUCTING LIFE

The guest coaches include Leon Silvers, who developed drag therapy into a clinical practice; a professional MUA and choreographer; plus community mentors and drag artists including Beardoncé and Champagna, who offer sage advice from their experiences of working as drag artists around the world. The participants dive deep into their personal lives to create emotional and cathartic performances.

THE NOBEL BROTHERS

The Nobel Brothers is a sweeping historical drama tracing the extraordinary journey of Robert, Ludvig, and Alfred Nobel – from childhood tragedy in Stockholm to global prominence. When their brilliant yet reckless father Immanuel loses everything, the young brothers vow to restore the family's honour. In St. Petersburg, they grow into men shaped by hardship: Alfred the visionary chemist, Ludvig the bold industrialist, and Robert the restless entrepreneur. Together they build on their father's legacy, founding "Nobel & Sons" and later Branobel, one of the world's great oil empires. But ambition comes at a cost. Alfred's invention of dynamite makes him both famous and feared. Ludvig pioneers social reforms for workers but clashes fiercely with Alfred over money and responsibility. Robert, embittered by setbacks, struggles to find his place. Love, rivalry, and devastating tragedies fracture their pact of unity, yet their drive never falters. The saga culminates in Alfred's will, establishing the Nobel Prizes. Out of genius, loss, and ambition, the name Nobel becomes forever linked with progress, science, and peace.



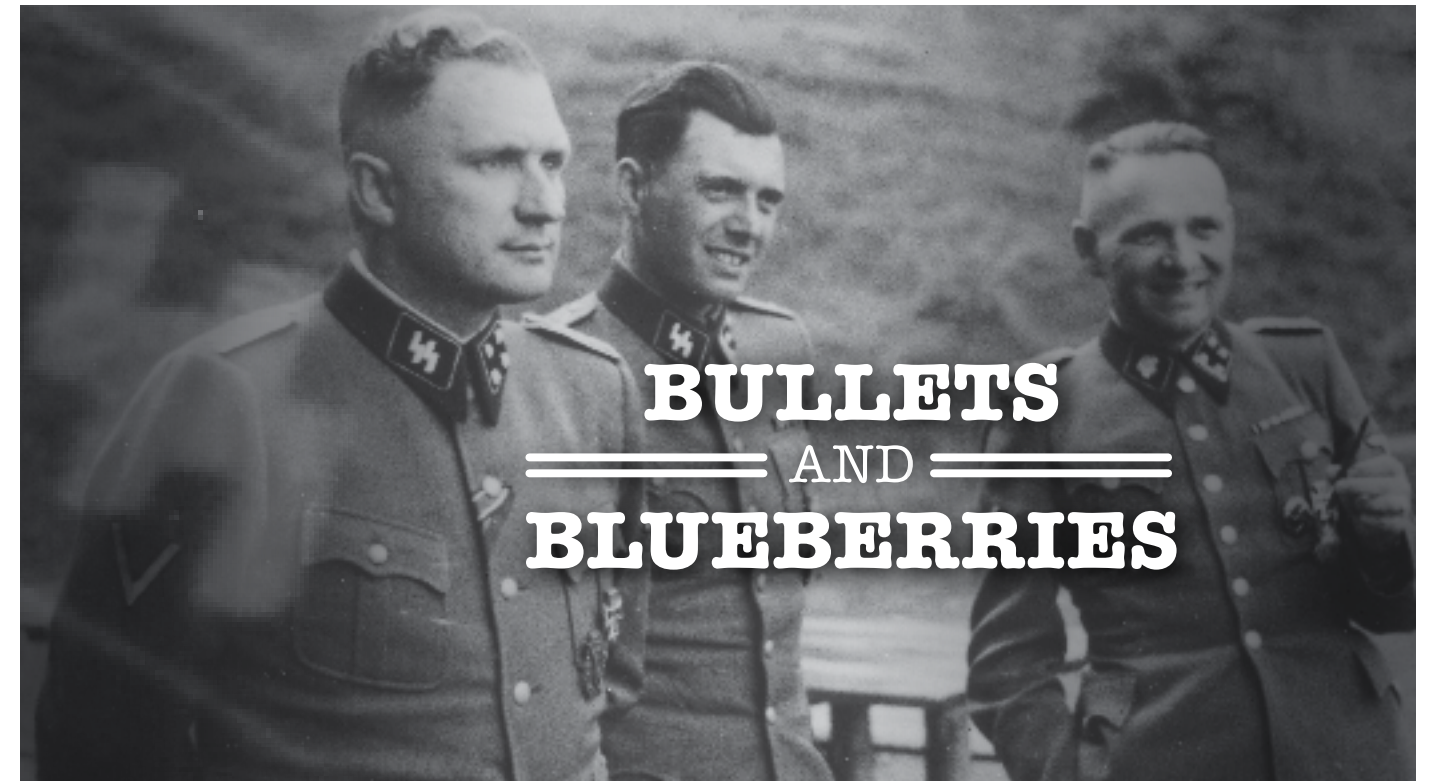

THEY FIGHT WITH CAMERAS

NEW RELEASE – 1 x 55' HD | Santa Barbara Indie Film Fest 2025: Best Documentary

World War II was the most visually documented event in history, with tens of thousands of images and countless feet of motion picture footage recorded by cameramen in every branch of the armed services in both the Allied and Axis forces. In America, LIFE magazine photographers Robert Capa and W. Eugene Smith achieved lasting recognition for their dramatic war photographs. But because photographers and motion-picture cameramen in the U.S. military were not credited by name, they have remained anonymous to this day. But no longer! By combining Signal Corps combat cameraman Walter Rosenblum's photographs and motion picture footage with his After-Action Reports and his recently discovered letters to his wife, his filmmaker daughter Nina and her partner Daniel Allentuck have created a unique and compelling account of her father's wartime exploits. One of the most decorated combat cameramen of World War II, Rosenblum recorded many of its pivotal events, from the D-Day landings on Omaha Beach to the liberation of the Dachau concentration camp and city of Munich.



BULLETS AND BLUEBERRIES

NEW RELEASE – 1 x 90' 4K

The Holocaust began with indiscriminate mass shootings by the Einsatzgruppen in the bloodlands of Eastern Europe in late 1941 and concluded in the gas chambers at Auschwitz in the summer of 1944. **Bullets And Blueberries** explores the motives and methods of the perpetrators, featuring shocking, never-before-seen photographs taken by the killers themselves – photographs that capture the banality of evil. During the Holocaust, the organized annihilation of over 6,000,000 men, women and children was kept hidden, but photographs were taken and kept as a kind of twisted souvenir by the killers – killers who were proud of their crimes. This documentary uses those photographs to put the killers back on trial, and to celebrate the victims whose existence was denied and destroyed. The film features interviews with Holocaust survivors, scholars and an encounter with Ben Ferencz, the then 27 year old lawyer who successfully prosecuted the Einsatzgruppen death merchants. It is a harrowing, but necessary journey into the heart of darkness, a still relevant document of what happens when you strip the “human” away from humanity.





RESISTANCE: THEY FOUGHT BACK

We've all heard of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, but most people have no idea how widespread and prevalent Jewish resistance to Nazi barbarism was. Instead, it's widely believed "Jews went to their deaths like sheep to the slaughter." **Resistance: They Fought Back** corrects this myth of Jewish passivity, powerfully illustrating the uprising in ghettos large and small, rebellions in death camps, and armed resistance in the forests.



JFK: 24 HOURS THAT CHANGED THE WORLD

1 x 46' HD | Created for the 60th anniversary

JFK: The Final Evidence (2 x 45') is also available.

Over the course of an hour, this full archive special covers the last 24 hours of President John F Kennedy's term, and the subsequent arrest and murder of apparent sole gunman Lee Harvey Oswald. In **JFK: 24 Hours that Changed the World**, we follow Kennedy from his arrival on the 21st November 1963, through to his body being taken by Air Force One to Washington DC, in an hour-by-hour recital of the events. Featuring incredible footage, photos and oral histories that have only recently been digitised, this documentary sets out to bring unheard voices to the forefront. Set against a mix of rich archive and music of the era, this is perhaps the most significant, unbiased documentary of the infamous event.



PHILLY ON FIRE

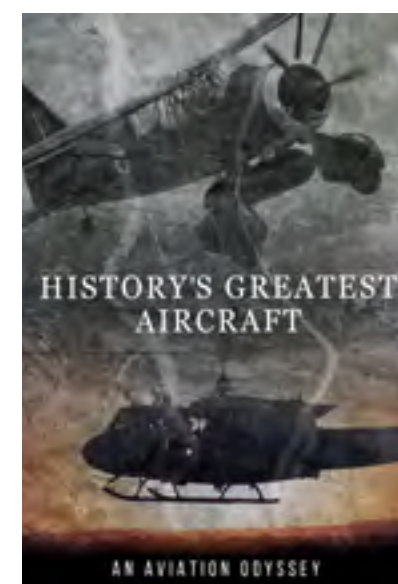
On May 13th, 1985, the Philadelphia police bombed a house in West Philly, starting the worst fire in the city's history. 11 people died, including five children. Only two survived: Ramona and Birdie. **Philly on Fire** tells the story of the bombing of Black liberation group MOVE through the voices of the people who lived it. Survivor Ramona tells her full story for the first time, alongside the police officer who saved Birdie, and Birdie's father. They recall Philly's troubled racial history, and the horrific police brutality MOVE were subjected to. Rich in archival assets and incredible access, this unprecedented, gripping film reveals the myriad causes of the disaster while ultimately offering a silver lining and path to reconciliation.



D-DAY: THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY

Produced for the 80th anniversary of D-Day, this film shows a different side to these famous events: not only the familiar shots of the beaches at Normandy, but also the faces of the troops, sailors, and civilians. The scenes of those preparing on the South Coast of England, as well as the sights which confronted the soldiers when they landed in France. Extraordinary archive, including rare, unseen, and colour materials, follows the men into battle, and the ensuing days in France. Sound archive of personal testimony allows us to hear the voices of those who were there on the day, as well as extremely rare radio broadcasts. The visuals include a mixture of original colour, as well as colourised sections.



HISTORY'S GREATEST AIRCRAFT

Funded by A+E UK and CEEMEA, this series examines many of the greatest contributions to modern warfare, capturing and celebrating some of the biggest icons in aircraft history. The highly acclaimed series has been expanded to include a whole new breed of aircraft – as we move into the jet age. One highlight is the incredible story of America's F15. Civil aircraft feature too, such as the record-breaking DH88, alongside the Cessna 02 that served in Vietnam. As ever, the producers have the full backstory, incredible untold tales, technical details, stunning cinematography and veterans' tales.



ROSWELL 75: THE FINAL EVIDENCE

This two-part documentary embarks on an enthralling investigation into the world's most famous UFO incident, unravelling the enigma that has intrigued and baffled generations. The documentary delves into the events of 1947 in Roswell, New Mexico, where the possibility of a mysterious extraterrestrial craft crashing has captivated imaginations and fuelled speculation for decades. Did a UFO indeed crash in Roswell, was it a secret military aircraft or a weather balloon? Were aliens, possibly alive and injured, recovered from the scene? Was there an autopsy, and did figures like Albert Einstein play a role in the aftermath? Dr David Hall and ufologist Anna Whitty set out to answer these questions.

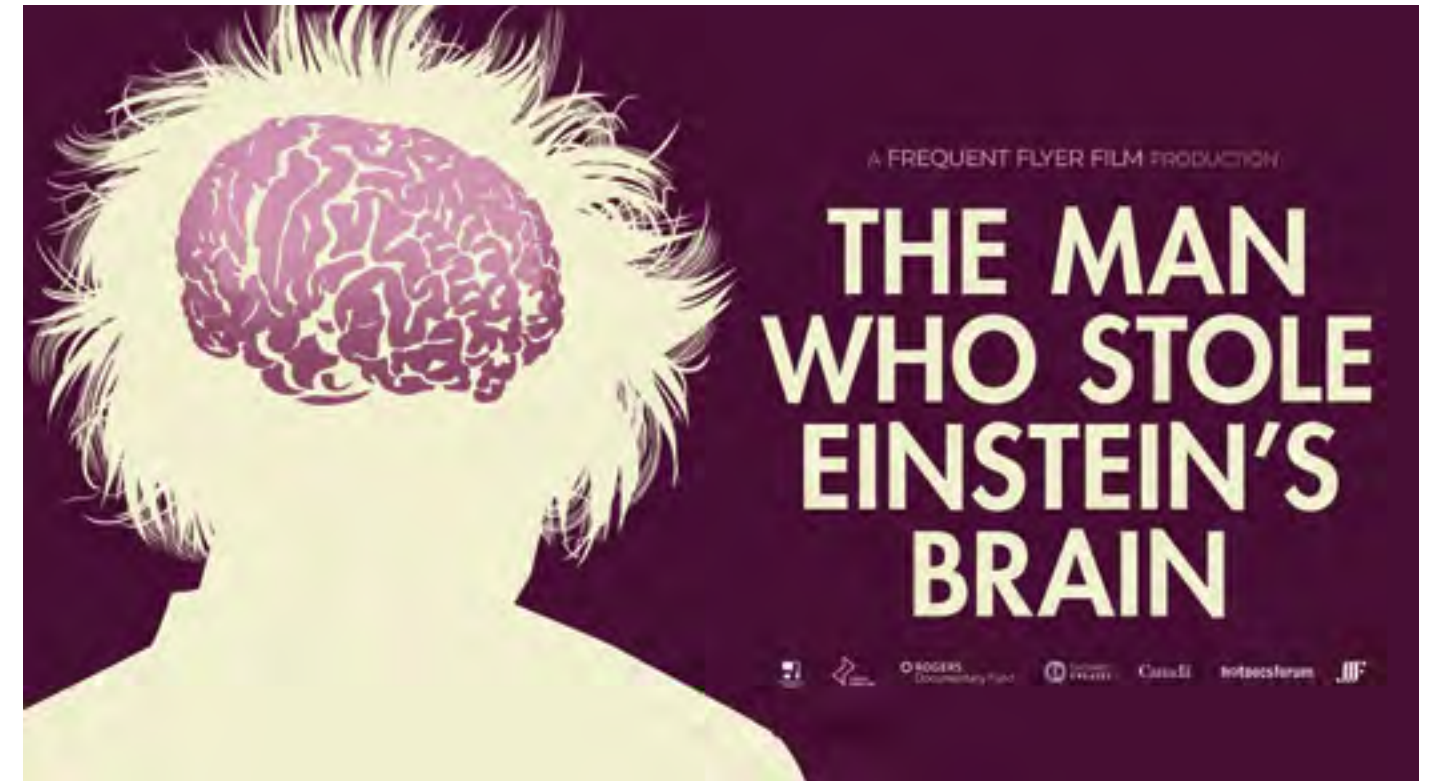


FOO FIGHTERS: THEN AND NOW

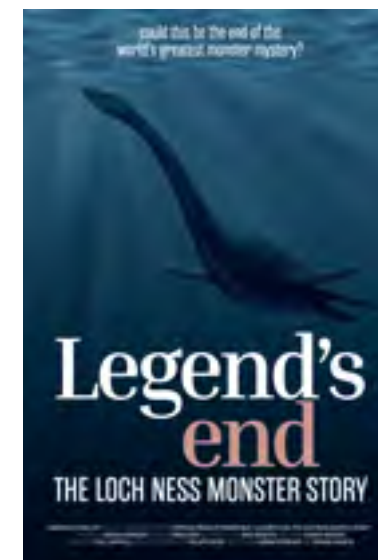
In the last two years of WWII, pilots began reporting strange aerial objects flying alongside their aircraft. Were pilots hallucinating or mistaking weather patterns? Or were these sightings of Extra Terrestrial origin? Have the governments of the world tapped into alien, off-world technology – or would they simply like us to think that, to hide their secret programmes? With incredible archive footage, accounts, rare declassified photographs and previously unseen reports, **Foo Fighters: Then And Now** tries to uncover the likely truth; and examine the technology that's once again seeing a boom in 'foo fighter' sightings.



THE MAN WHO STOLE EINSTEIN'S BRAIN

He believes it will solve the mystery of genius and make him a scientific star, but the decision will haunt the rest of his life. This is the little-known, bizarre story of Dr. Thomas Stoltz Harvey, the chief pathologist who steals the brain from Albert Einstein's corpse while performing the autopsy on the world's most famous scientist. While Einstein's family demands the brain be returned, Harvey strikes a secret deal with the estate to safeguard it for science – but science is not yet up to the job, and Harvey can never outrun the power of Einstein's celebrity. Quirky and poignant, this stranger-than-fiction portrait features a rich archive, interviews with those who knew Harvey best, and rare access to Harvey's recorded words.



LEGEND'S END: THE LOCH NESS MONSTER STORY

A passionate community, devoted to the world's greatest monster myth is disrupted when an ambitious scientist begins the final, definitive search for the Loch Ness Monster. Steve lives in a static caravan on the shores of Loch Ness, having given up his job 30 years ago to become a full-time 'monster hunter' for the legendary plesiosaur. He's eagerly awaiting the next piece of evidence. Leading the latest scientific quest is Professor Neil Gemmell, a Nessie sceptic.

Could there be a plesiosaur in Loch Ness – or could it be a Greenland Shark or giant eels? At a packed press conference, he claims there is no plesiosaur DNA, but reveals that 20% of the DNA is inconclusive... the legend of the Loch Ness Monster lives on.

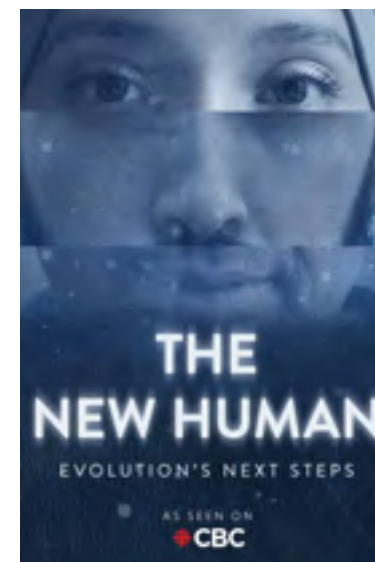

Responding to an ever-growing influx of recent AI technologies being indiscriminately unleashed onto the world, this highly entertaining documentary examines how AI is shaping us as individuals and as a society. 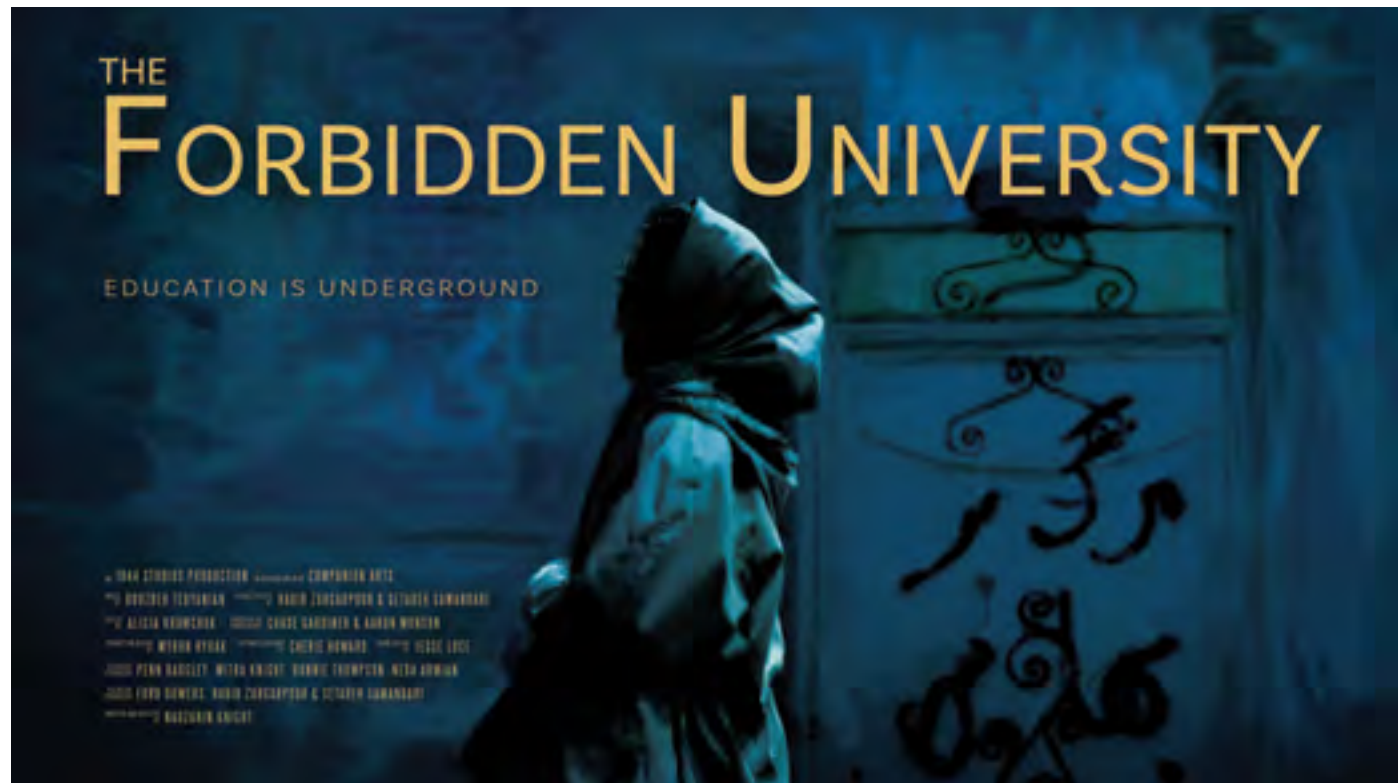


SHADES OF SURVIVAL

Their stories reveal the resilience of a community that transforms kitchens into classrooms, smuggles textbooks across city lines, and risks imprisonment to learn. At once a thriller and a meditation on the cost of knowledge, **The Forbidden University** is a powerful testament to the courage of those who struggle for education.



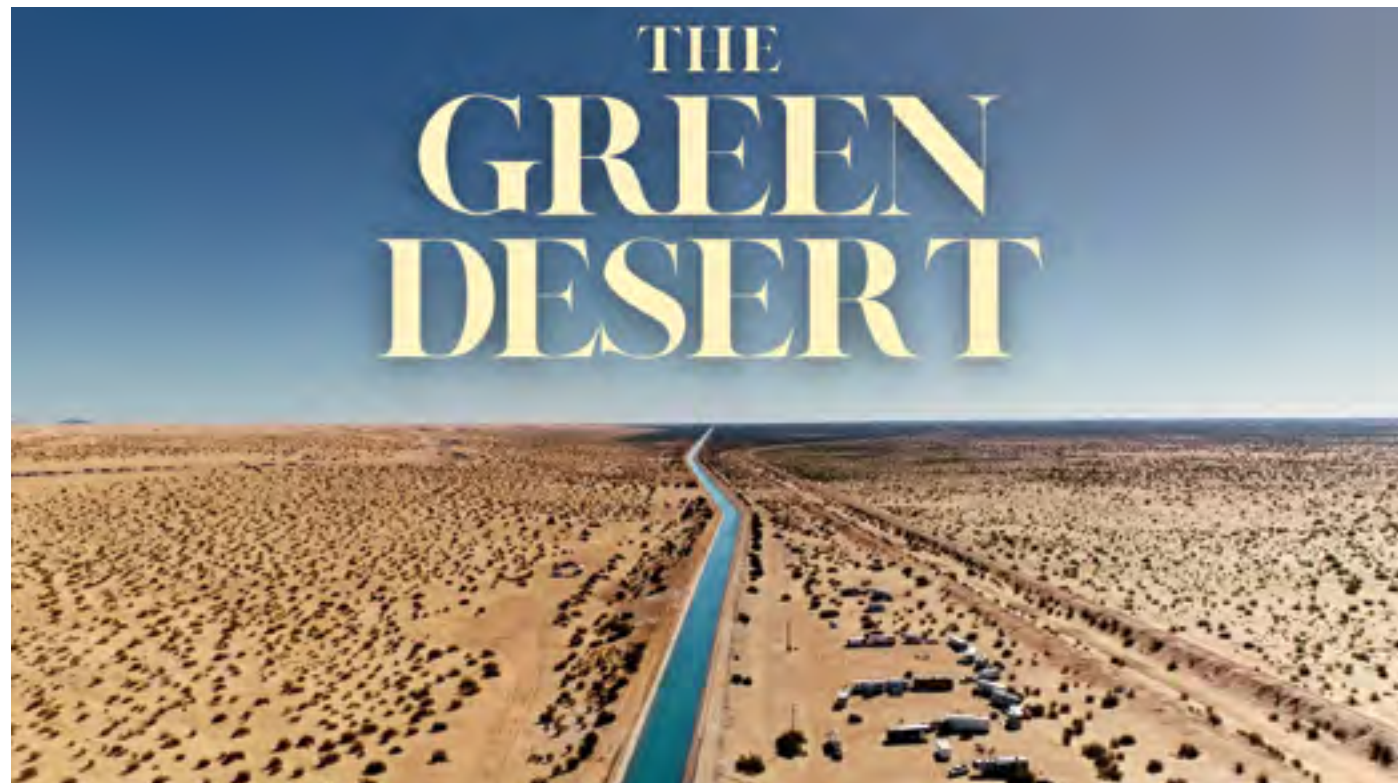
POISED

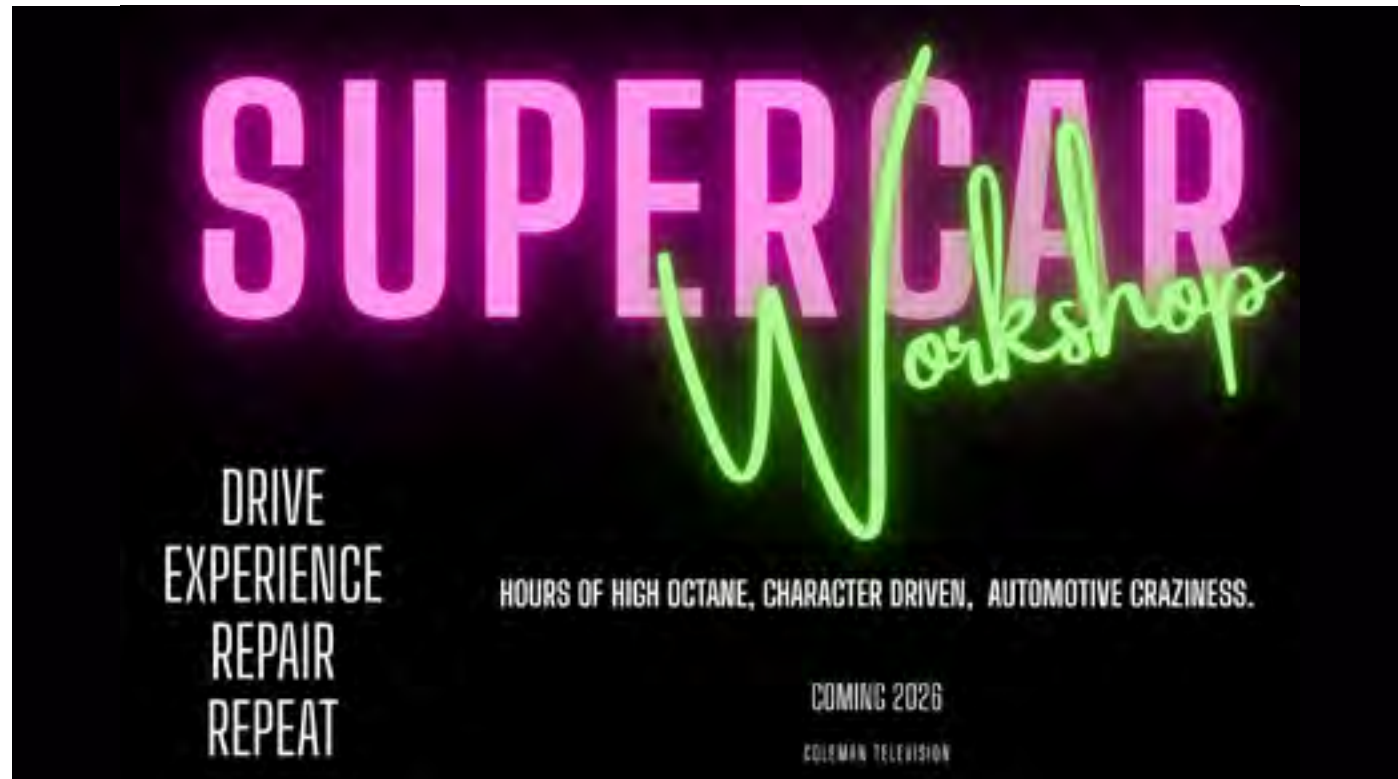

In January 1945, as the Allies tighten their grip on the crumbling Nazi regime, thousands of Allied POWs are caught in the crossfire. Catchpole and Fulton, two British POWs with a strained relationship, find themselves in a Nazi camp in Poland. Ordered by Himmler, the Nazi guards hastily evacuate the camp, forcing the prisoners on a deadly march west, towards Germany.

As the march grinds on, reverse-chronological flashbacks reveal the journey of Catchpole and Fulton's friendship, from carefree pals in Essex to the day they enlisted, motivated by the desire for adventure and glory. Their chaotic first mission as Lancaster pilots ended in disaster, leading to their capture. In the present, they face brutal conditions, starvation, and deadly attacks, including friendly fire from Russian planes. Fulton escapes with Australian POW Rogers, but their bid for freedom ends in tragedy, as both are captured again.

The untold story of how the Royal Navy's aviation arm has been helping Britain win wars since 1914, by perfecting the hardest job in flight – landing on a moving ship.

Ten WW2 veterans tell their stories for the first time on camera: they all served in the Royal Navy's Fleet Air Arm (FAA). Later FAA crews crew bring alive 1950s campaigns in Korea and Suez, while Navy pilots who fought Argentina in 1982 reveal they were key to recapturing the Falklands. We'll meet the FAA pilot who destroyed Iraq's navy in 1991. We've filmed some forty veterans, who describe the reality of operating an airport at sea. We've also had rare access to today's FAA on land and at sea, enabling us to create spectacular cinematography of a working naval air service. And, guiding our story, we have Admiral Sir Ben Key, the Navy's chief, and TV historian Dan Snow. Kristin Scott Thomas may narrate this documentary. Kate, Princess of Wales, is now the FAA's Commodore: we have asked to interview her.
